The performers and audience will stop when we get the ADHD Umbrella arts installation.

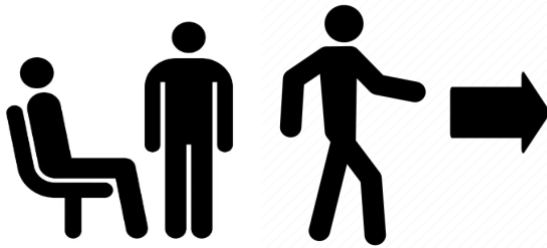
The dancers will perform and sing again underneath the umbrella's.

I am Steve. I am the BSL interpreter. I will sign what people say.







	<p>This is performed on the grass area at the side of the Spitfire Gallery</p>
